

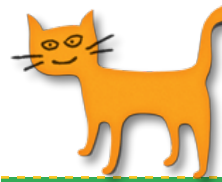

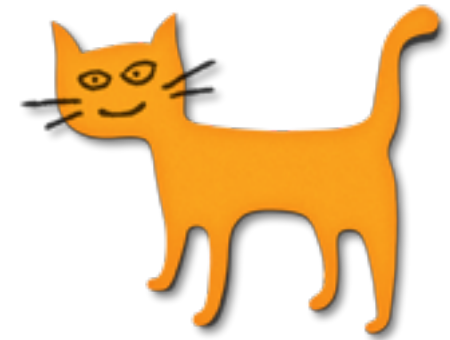
- a bed

Feeding Your Cat

- Your cat should always have fresh water
- Dry foods are convenient but your cat will need more water if this is their only food
- Wet food should be at room temp.

What NOT to feed your cat

- Do not give cow's milk to cats, especially to kittens
- Do not feed cats with dog food
- Do not feed your cats scraps such as rice- there is not enough protein, fats, vitamins, etc.

Grooming

- Cats are very clean animals and they can groom themselves if they have short hair
- Long haired cats need more help to avoid getting tangles
- Introduce your cat to the brush when it is young- they usually enjoy it

Neutering

- As a responsible owner you will sterilise your cat as soon as possible
- Both males and females can be sterilised at around 12 weeks
- There are many advantages to neutering - speak to your vet

TOILET TRAINING

- SHOW THE CAT THE LITTER TRAY - THAT IS USUALLY ENOUGH
- CLEAN THE LITTER TRAY EVERYDAY - CATS HATE DIRTY LITTER

PLAYING

- PLAYING AND SOCIALISING IS VERY IMPORTANT TO CATS - MAKE SURE THEY HAVE PLENTY OF TOYS
- INTRODUCE THEM TO A SCRATCHING POST - THEY NEED TO SCRATCH TO REMOVE THE OUTER CASING FROM THEIR CLAWS
- NEVER DE-CLAW A CAT! THIS IS VERY CRUEL AND VERY PAINFUL
